
Subject: Response to "Conflict Minerals" requirements in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act


"Conflict Minerals" consist of **columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite** and their derivatives which are initially limited to **tantalum, tin, and tungsten**, that have been mined in or smelted in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or any of its adjoining countries Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia (collectively referred to as "Covered Countries").
